



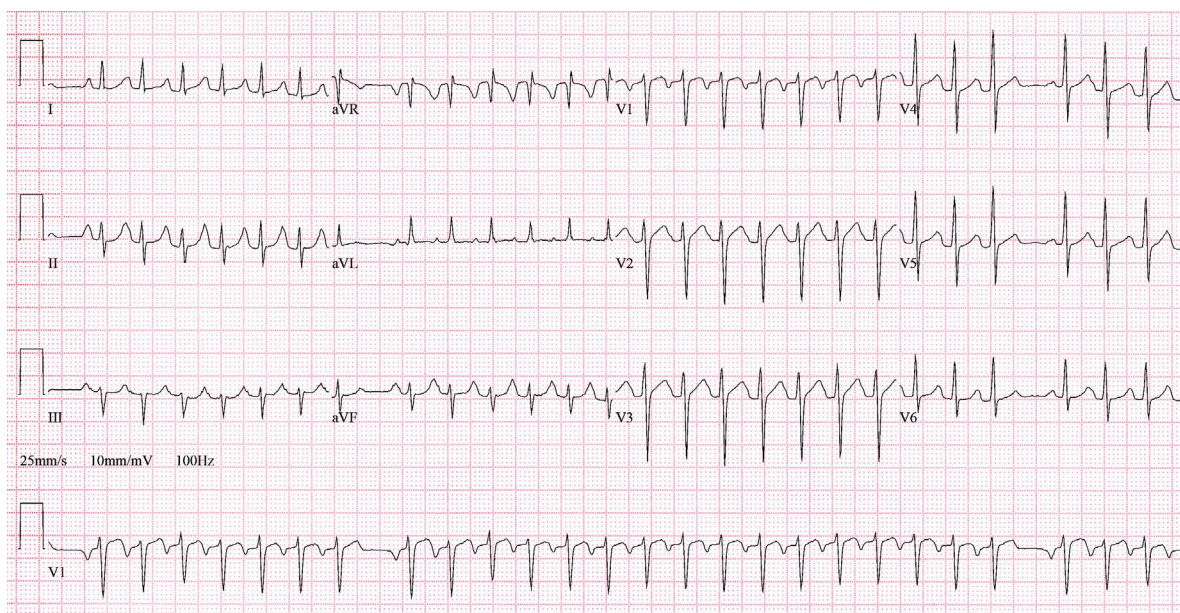
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This 49-year-old man had a history of intermittent, fast, irregular palpitations. Which ONE of the following is the best electrocardiogram (ECG) diagnosis?
