COVER LETTER: Health Related Quality of Life in a PD-First Programme in South Africa.

Dear Editor,

It is with pleasure that we submit our manuscript to your journal to be considered for publication. Our current paper is an original article reporting Health Related Quality of Life outcomes in a Peritoneal Dialysis First programme in South Africa, a middle-income country where patient choice is limited. There is a paucity of outcome data, including quality of life data in PD-First programmes. We are convinced that this work will be relevant for PD services in other low-middle income countries.

This work describes the comparison between renal specific and non-renal specific quality of life aspects between haemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis. We also report the challenges of PD in poor socioeconomic circumstances and possible solutions to improve the experience of PD in this setting.
